Dogger Bank D is a new proposed offshore wind farm that will connect to the UK power grid in East Riding of Yorkshire. It is a potential fourth phase of the Dogger Bank Wind Farm, the world's largest offshore wind farm.

Our proposals detail where we've identified a location near Skipsea as the landfall for where the electricity generated from the wind turbines could be brought ashore. From there, we have broad corridors where underground cables could be routed across the East Riding to bring the electricity to a converter station near to a new substation at Birkhill Wood which is being developed by National Grid.
